

Driving the BMW I3

- 1) To power up the vehicle, fully depress the brake pedal and press the START STOP button located on the gear selector stalk (to the right of the wheel).
The dashboard will light up and the car should display it is READY and have your range, speedometer etc.
If it lights up with all warning lights, you are not logged into the Co-wheels system. Present your card at the blue reader again



- 2) To select your gear, keep your foot on the brake and push the gear selector on the steering wheel away from you to move to D or towards you to N and R

D= Drive

N= Neutral

R= Reverse

- 3) Release the parking brake by pressing the (P) button down with your foot on the footbrake. (the red light will turn off and you will feel the footbrake release slightly) Ease off the footbrake and the car will start to creep forward in D or backwards in R

Please Note*

When driving the I3 the vehicle will rapidly decelerate when you take your foot off the accelerator



Continue to reverse....



4) When parking the car press the Park button P on the gear selector whilst depressing the footbrake

5) Pull the parking brake (P) towards you to engage the parking brake and the red light will illuminate (you will feel the footbrake go heavy)

Once the parking brake is on, press the START STOP button WITHOUT your foot on the footbrake and the car will power down.

Please ensure the vehicle is powered down before leaving the car



6) To put the vehicle on charge gently push the charging flap in and it will release.

Once opened, plug the charging cable into the top charging port (7-pins) and then connect to the charging point. If the charging point requires a charging card this can be found in the vehicle's on board computer (near the rear view mirror) and please follow the instructions on the charge point

To indicate that the vehicle is charging the white trim around the charging flap interior trim will glow blue. If the interior glows orange the car is waiting to charge. If the charge glows red there is an issue. If this occurs, please unconnect the cable and start again
